Aims and objectives of the committee

- 1. To look after the day to day interests of the Proprietors in all matters relating to the maintenance and upkeep of the common areas.
- 2. To provide such assistance as may be appropriate and practicable to proprietors with regard to interest in their property.
- 3. To provide a mechanism for convening meetings of owners in accordance with the deed of conditions
- 4. To safeguard and promote the interests of the owners on matters concerning the management of the development
- 5. To create a positive working and living relationship neighbours to attain the best possible environment at the most competitive cost.
- 1. Who can be on Proprietors' Association Glasgow Harbour (TWD) Management Committee?

On purchase of a property, owners automatically become members of the Association.

2. How many people can make up the Proprietors' Association Glasgow Harbour (TWD) Management Committee?

The management committee should consist of Chairperson, Vice Chairperson Secretary and 9 (nine) committee members.

3. How long can individuals serve on the Proprietors' Association Glasgow Harbour (TWD) Management Committee?

Members of the management committee should hold office for one year and also shall be eligible for re-election every year.

- 4. How do Committee members resign or stand down?
- Should you wish to resign from the committee you must notify the Secretary in writing.
- **5.** Requirements set out for nominating and electing individual committee members? Members of the management committee shall be elected at an annual general meeting or vacancies can be filled by election at a meeting of the committee the person elected shall hold office until the next annual general meeting.
